

# Landings Neighborhood Watch -- For Your Information

The Town Hall Meeting for this quarter covered Traffic Enforcement, Animal Control as well as the usual Q & A Session for Block Watch Captains. Barry Lee, Tim Burnside and myself attended. The following is my attempt to capture and share the information for our Neighborhood Watch Members.

## TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT:

- The Sgt. Leading the C.A.R.E. Team presented a detailed explanation of the methods used to enforce traffic laws in CDA

- Especially dangerous intersections were pointed out:
  - They are Kathleen at both Ramsey and at Hwy 95 (the Ramsey intersection is apparently notorious for Red Light Runners – we were advised to wait a bit after the light turns green, especially here)
  - There are a few Hotspots on Government Way and also along 4<sup>th</sup> street
- Other questions were raised regarding the timing of Signal Lights and the addition of a left turn lane heading west on Appleway onto Hwy 95 north
- Our own Barry Lee asked about timing of traffic lights along Prairie Ave at both Huetter and Atlas.
- In response Chief of Police Longo said that there will be another Town Hall Meeting (probably in July) where they will invite Traffic Engineers (from Post Falls, CDA, and ITD) to answer questions -- towards that end the Chief suggested sending Email questions for the Engineers to Sgt. Christy Wood ([wood@cdaid.org](mailto:wood@cdaid.org)) ahead of the meeting
